- Proposals for the use and maintenance of the asset;
- Benefits to the authority, the community-based group (if applicable) and the wider community;
- Consideration of whether there are, and will continue to be, any conflicts/overlap with other similar facilities in the locality;
- Affordability information and evidence of financial support, the detail of which should reflect the scale of the asset that is being considered;
- The proposal must evidence that there has been consideration of Equality and accessibility by all groups and have regard to the Welsh Language Standards.
