1. Application

- 1.1 This is an application for a new premises licence under section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003. **Appendix 2**
- 1.2 The application is for a time limited premises licence for a one day only event that will take place on the 25th June 2023 in Talacre Gardens. The event is to commemorate the 75th anniversary of the arrival of HMS Windrush to Britain and the contribution made by Caribbean members of the Windrush generation. The application is for:
 - a) Supply of Alcohol (For consumption on the premises)
 - b) Live Music
 - c) Recorded Music
 - d) Performance of dance

12:00 – 19:00 Sunday

e) Opening hours

12:00 – 19:00 Sunday

1.3 The premises is a public park that is open to the public from 07:00 hours until 20:30. If the application is granted the premises licence will cease to exist once the event has taken place.

2. Representations

- 2.1 Two relevant representations have been received in relation to the application. One from Friends of Talacre and one from a local resident both opposing the application. These representations are attached at **Appendix 3**
- 2.2 The applicant as part of the application process has engaged with the statutory Responsible Authorities none of whom have made representations.
 - Having engaged with the Responsible Authorities including the Police, Environmental Health, Health & Safety and the Licensing Authority, the applicant has agreed to all 30 recommended conditions. These conditions are attached at **Appendix 5**
- 2.3 The applicant has also engaged with local resident and local stakeholders with meetings held at the Talacre Sports Centre on 16th March 2023 and 23rd May 2023.

As a result of these meetings and having regard to the concerns raised an updated version/living document of The Event Safety & Risk Management Plan has been produced and is attached at **Appendix 4**
