Details of representation

The original proposal for the renovated Town Hall - to become a place for co-working - local start ups, people from outside London needing desk space in London - made a lot of sense to me. But what is now proposed, an events venue with late night drinking on roof terraces, increased taxi traffic delivering and collecting, almost certainly increased drug dealing in surrounding streets, is going to have a big impact on residents of Queen

Alexandra Mansions especially. I dont live in QAM but I know people who do and I want to support their objections. I would feel happier about this application if it was made by a company with a clear track record in events management. But the Bottaccio website tells me nothing - no addresses, prices, contact details. Though interesting that they use an image of the Prince of Wales to advertise themselves. I think this licensing application should be refused, pending a thorough audit of Camden's relationship with this firm, how it came about, what was promised, and how the applicants have behaved in their dealings with the local community, especially neighbour residents.
