Dear Camden Council,

The Metropolitan Police **withdraw** the above representation in regards to K Club as the Police and the applicant have agreed to an amendment to the proposed hours and conditions. Please can the following times and conditions be added to any variation of the licence that is granted. Please note the applicant is no longer extending the hours of licensable activities at the end of each day and instead are intending to open earlier in the afternoon only.

The MPS agree to the removal of condition 25 and 48.

Sale of alcohol/Late night refreshments/Regulated entertainment:

Monday – Saturday: 1400 – 0300

Sunday: 1700 – 0000

Additional conditions:

1. CCTV must cover all areas where licensable activities take place.
2. On Sundays there will be reservations only for all customers with no walk-ins allowed.
3. On Monday to Saturday after midnight, only pre-booked guests will be allowed to enter the

- premises, no walk-ins will be permitted access.
4. On Sundays the capacity of the premise will be reduced from 200 to 100 guests.
 5. Guests will be informed upon booking to use Kingsway Street, rather than Parker Street, for pick-up/drop-off.
 6. Guests will be required to wait for transportation inside the venue rather than on the street.
 7. The premises will display clear pick-up/drop-off guidelines and notice at the entrance to remind all guests to be considerate when leaving the venue.
