1. Purpose of Report (and Reason for Urgency)

- 1.1. Camden Learning Limited is a private company limited by guarantee. The Council holds a 19% stake in the company, with the remainder being owned by Camden schools.
- 1.2. This report provides the audited accounts of Camden Learning Ltd. As Camden Learning is a separate legal entity, these accounts do not form part of the Council's own accounts. The Audit and Corporate Governance Committee's remit includes reviewing the governance and assurance arrangements for significant partnerships or collaboration and as part of that remit, have requested, for reasons of good governance and transparency, to see the audited accounts of wholly or partly owned Council bodies. The attached accounts are therefore presented for information only, although Committee members may offer comments or make recommendations for future actions.

2. Background

- 2.1 Camden Learning is commissioned by the Council to deliver various school improvement and support services. Camden Learning works in partnership with schools and the Council to help schools develop excellent practices which support the achievement of Camden's children. Much of the company's income is derived from services commissioned by the Council. The remainder is primarily derived from services purchased by Camden schools.
