I write in reference to the above premises and my representation regarding the non-compliance of the roof terrace to be used as an area for smoking, particular shisha pipes.

Following my second visit to the premises on the 13th January 2026, I have now received further photographic evidence from the business to demonstrate that more of the plastic sheet panels have been removed from the surrounding structure of the roof terrace. I am now satisfied that the area meets the minimal requirements to deem it 'substantially open' and therefore smoking can now be permitted.

As the business is now considered compliant, I would like to withdraw my representation dated 12th January 2026.
