I am a resident at [REDACTED] and note a meeting on Tuesday 10Th March

I would welcome an opportunity to talk about the existing road changes in Haverstock Hill and the proposed changes to traffic that will affect Parkhill Road, Lawn Road and Fleet Road

I am concerned that the changes have inadvertently made our streets less safe as they have ensured ease of access for individuals on electric bikes to ride up on the pavement and snatch mobile phones and then ride off having an easy escape route. Together with many shops now having to lock their doors to ensure they are not being robbed.

The zebra crossings are now dangerous as you essentially have 4 flows of traffic including two for bikes and that they rarely stop.

In addition I feel that the proposed changes to the flow of traffic in Parkhill will make it less safe as will direct traffic down more residential streets such as Lawn Road and Upper Park Road
