Many thanks for sending this information.

I would like to formally request to make a deputation at the Culture and Environment Scrutiny Committee meeting on Monday 23rd of March.

This is the bullet point summary of what I would like to say:

- My name is Alessandra Giuliani and I am a local resident, parent of three children attending affected schools, and co-founder of Green School Runs
- Strongly support the scheme and urge timely implementation
- Benefits include safer streets, cleaner air, and improved school journeys for many families
- Acknowledge valid technical concerns raised in the call-in, like:
 - Narrowing of pavement outside Fitzjohn's Primary may reduce safety
 - Tesco loading bay extension unlikely to solve congestion; prefer smaller delivery vehicles
- Less concerned about:
 - Shared pedestrian-cycle crossings (lower risk than cars; support cycling)
 - Loss of southbound St Mary's bus stop (minimal impact)

- Pedestrian priority at bus stops (adequately addressed in design)
- Strong support for scheme measures:
 - Healthy School Street on College Crescent
 - New cycle lane on Fitzjohn's Avenue
 - Additional pedestrian crossing and introduction of safer continuous crossings
- Overall, the scheme will support children's safety, independence, and health while reducing traffic
- Delays mean missed benefits for current children
- Request: address concerns at detailed design stage, but proceed with the scheme now
