

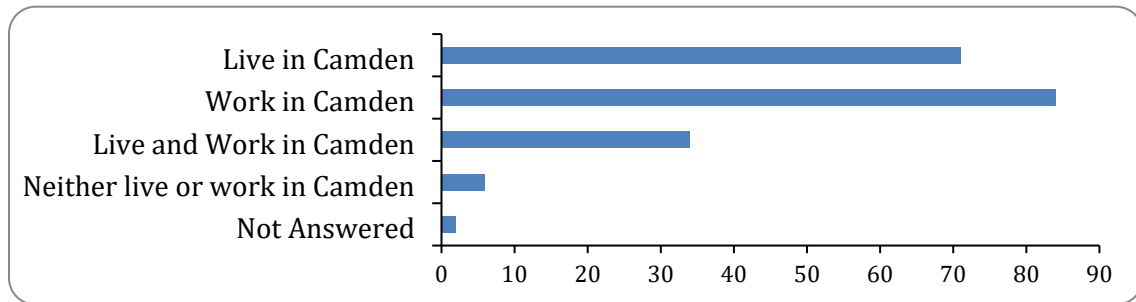

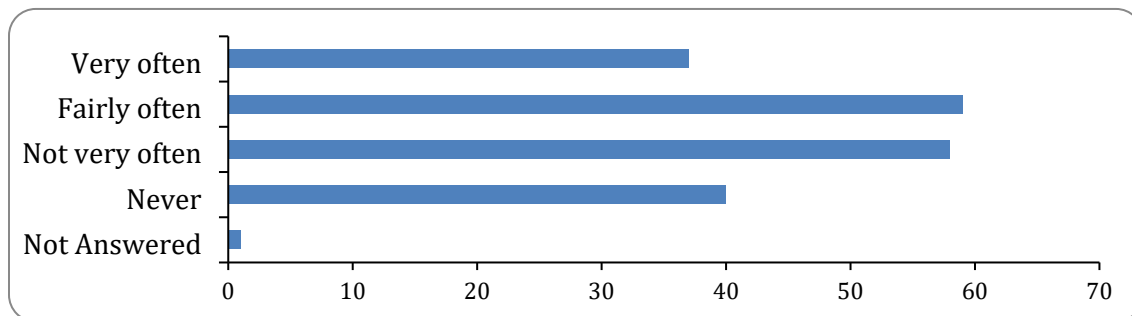

There were 194 responses to this part of the question.

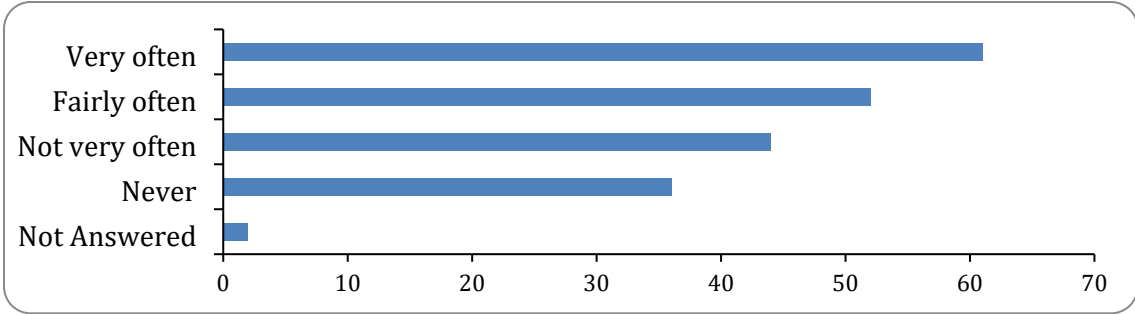

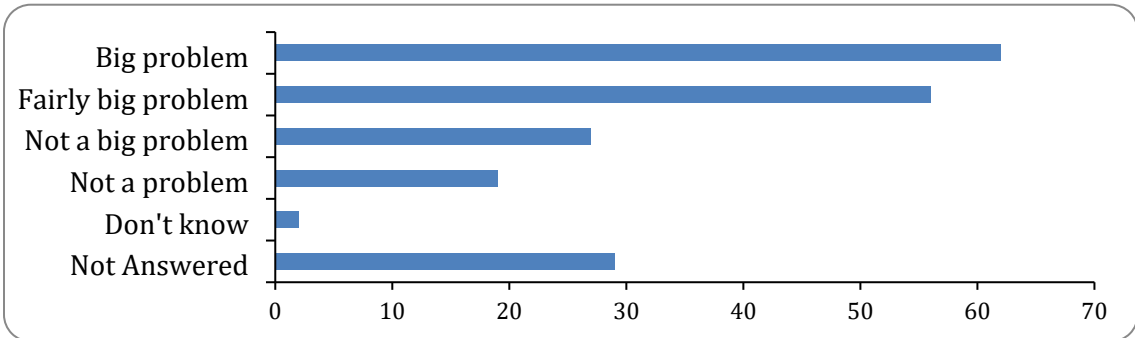

Issue ranking - Street drinking

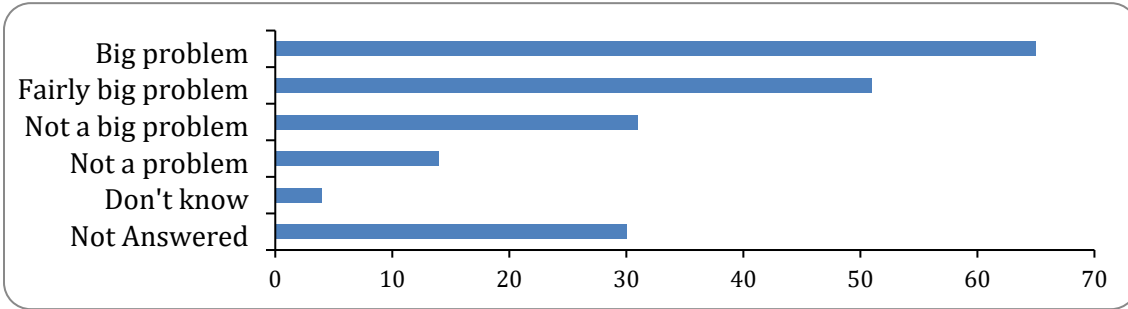

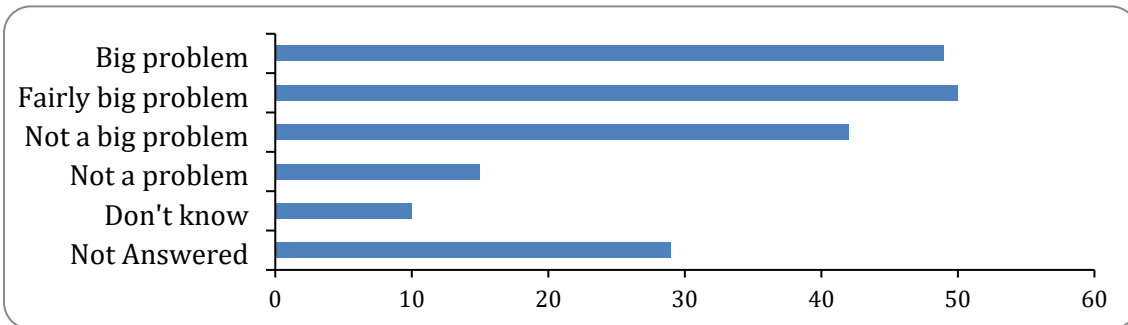

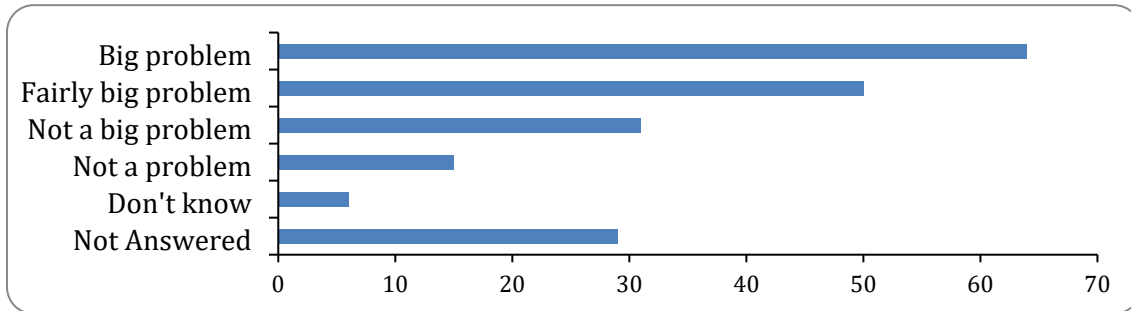

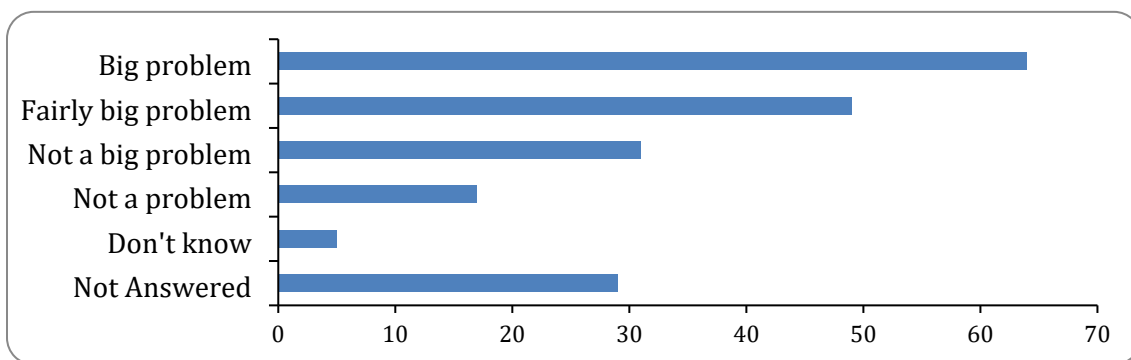

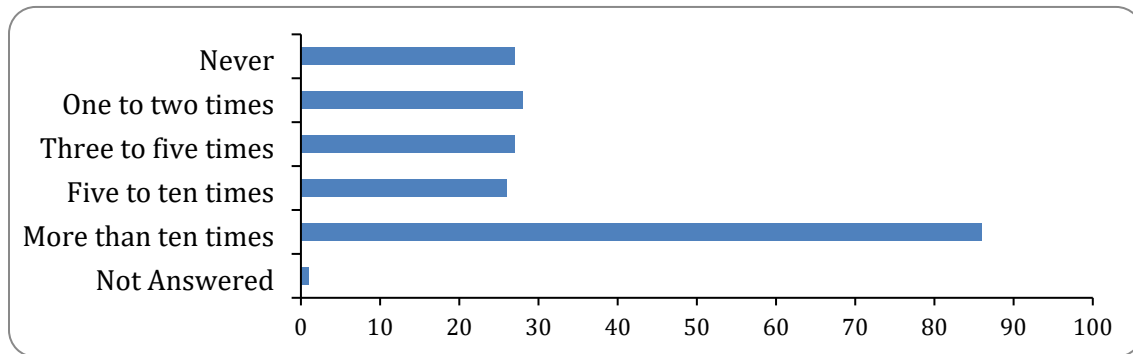

7: How does antisocial behaviour linked to people consuming alcohol in public places impact your life? If not applicable please leave blank.

There were 132 responses to this part of the question.

Analyzing the responses to this question, they can be broadly categorized into two categories: impacts on the physical environment and impacts on people.

Impacts on the physical environment includes issues such as litter, urination and defecation as well as a negative perception of areas. It was also a common theme that areas are avoided due to the ASB that has been witnessed/ occurs in the area.

Impacts on people included issues such as noise, intimidation, feeling unsafe, harassment and avoiding an area/ social isolation due to ASB stopping people going out in Camden.

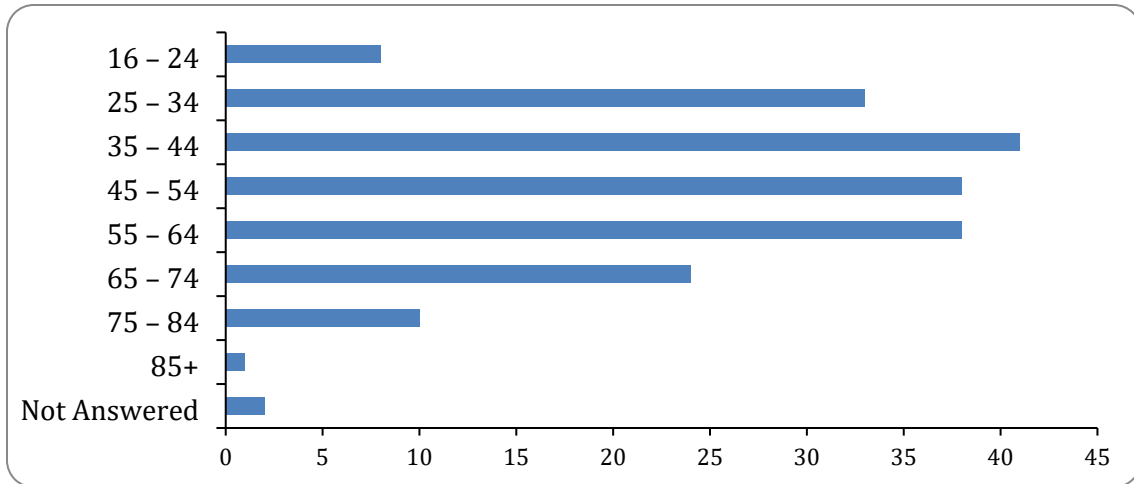

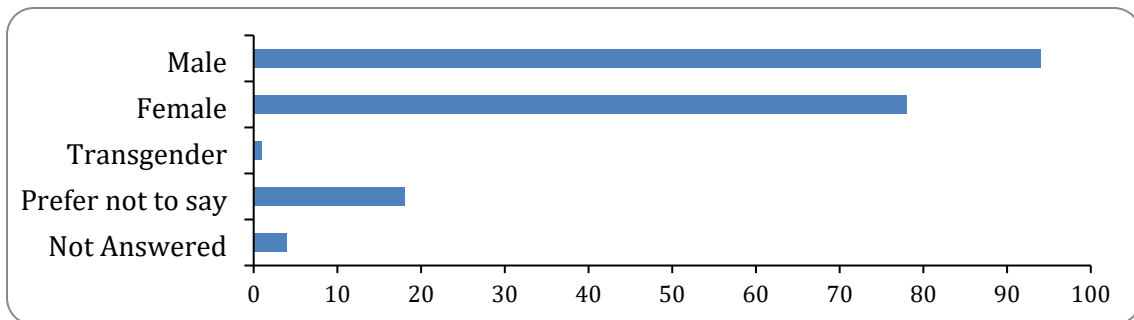

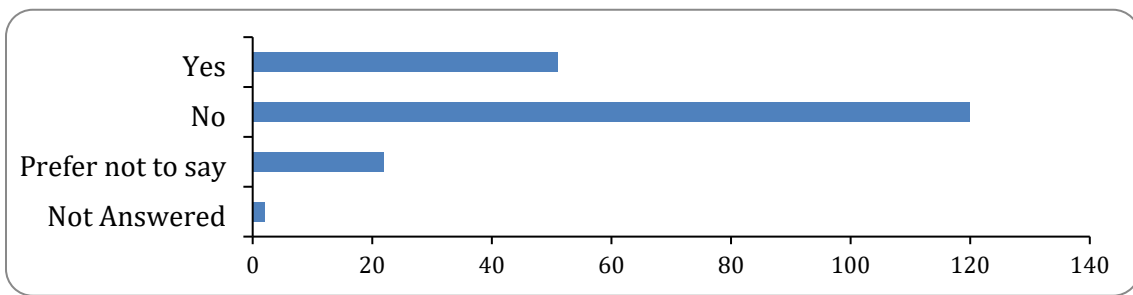

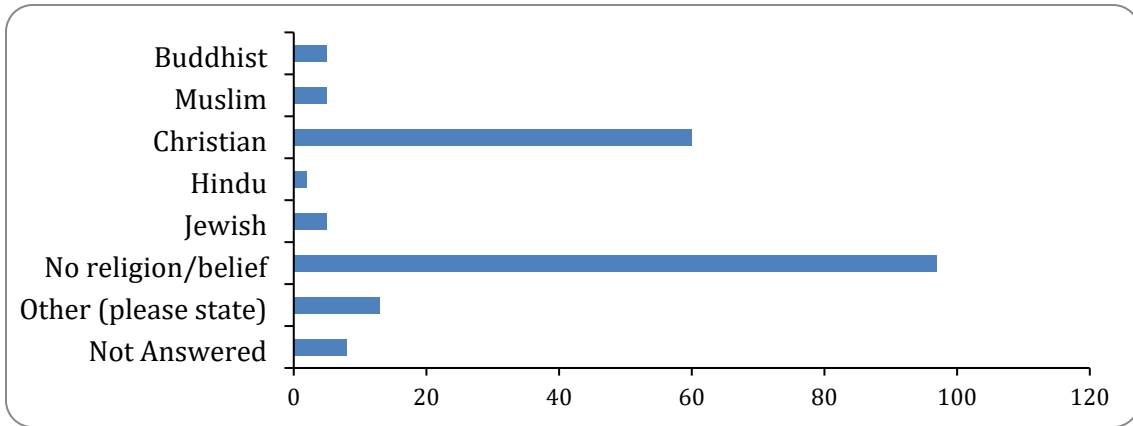

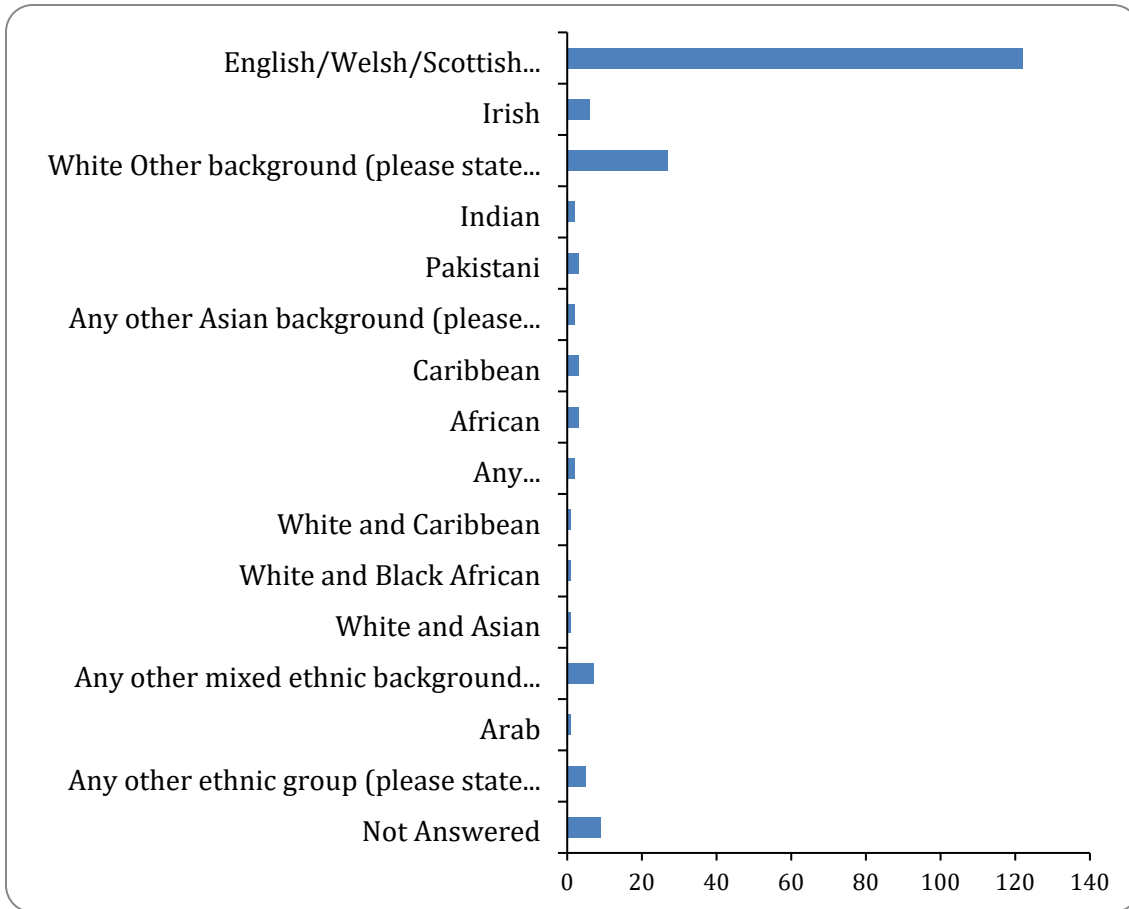

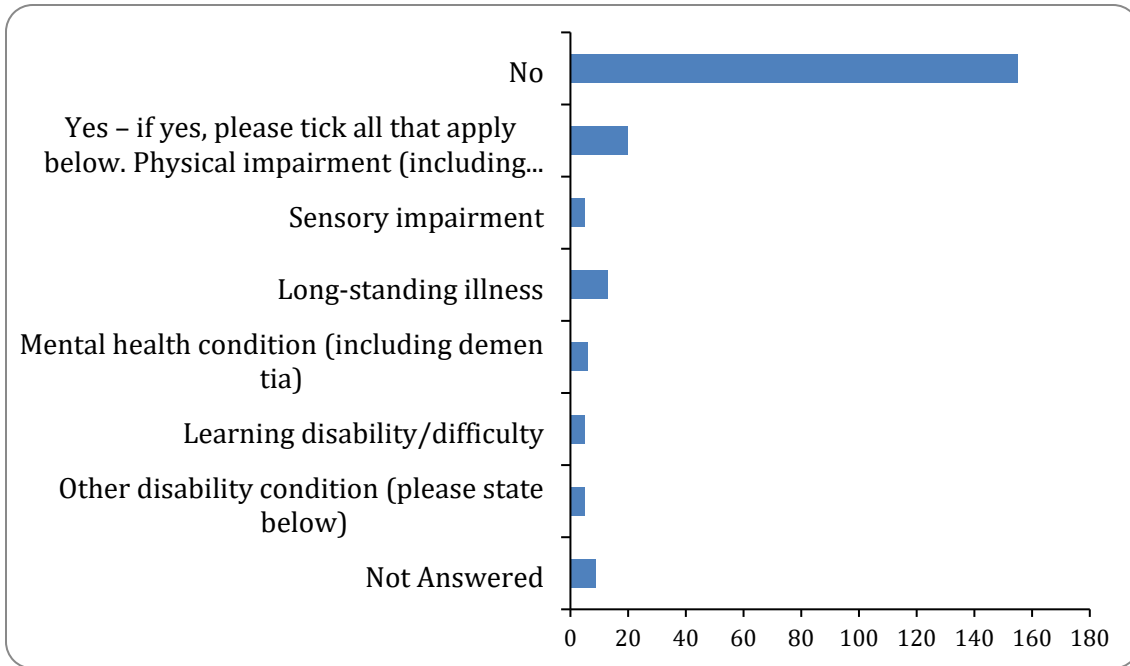
