Circumstances related to the application for a Determination remain broadly in line with when previous Determination was agreed.

This has also informed their decision to approve application.

i) organisational arrangements

The school offers daily assemblies and tutor time activities. Years 7-11 are all delivered PSHE during the same time each week, providing opportunities for sharing key themes and reflection time across the majority of the school population. The Sixth Form also have this dedicated time.

A "Theme of the Week" is shared across the staff body via various methods, such as staff briefings twice a week or within the weekly staff bulletin.

The whole school calendar is also shared across the staff body prior to publication to ensure there is time to consult and populate, key themes and events, including "share and celebrate" and noting key commemorative events for collective reflection.

Student Council have been consulted on this topic and have expressed interest in helping to review themes/ topics and opportunities across the school year. This work is ongoing at the school each academic year.

ii) themes/topics featured in the collective worship programme

In line with all Curricula in the school, Assemblies /Collective workshop programme is reviewed and sequenced on an annual basis. An example of draft planning is attached with this application. Please see attached “Draft sequence for Collective Worship.”
