Purpose of Report

The purpose of this report is to outline the strategic role of the Integrated Pipeline and the GM Good Growth Fund in driving Greater Manchester's growth and regeneration over the next decade. It sets out how the Integrated Pipeline will enable informed decision-making and effective resource allocation for key projects in employment, housing, transport, and infrastructure, while the £1bn Good Growth Fund will invest in priority schemes to deliver thousands of new homes, jobs, and employment space across all districts in support of the ambitions of the Greater Manchester Strategy.

The report includes a summary slide pack plus the November 2025 report to the Combined Authority (attached as an appendix) which sought approval to the launch of the Good Growth Fund and initial allocations.
