


# NHS Greater Manchester CQC Inspections and Quality Oversight October 25

# Introduction

- Integrated Care Boards (ICBs) have an overarching duty to ensure the services they commission are of a good quality
- NHS Greater Manchester (NHS GM) is aligned to the National Quality Board's Single View of Quality
- A Quality Assurance and Escalation Framework has been designed to ensure effective quality oversight of services, as well as a responsive approach when quality issues emerge
- Care Quality Commission (CQC) ratings are only one **part of a range** of quality intelligence tools that NHS GM uses to maintain quality oversight of our commissioned providers
- NHS GM meets regularly with the CQC to share intelligence regarding providers
- Discussions about CQC ratings are part of the Locality Assurance Mechanisms NHS GM already has in place.



# NHS GM – Overall Position – CQC

There are currently\* 1227 regulated providers and 4229 locations/services in the Greater Manchester area.

Not all of the services that are registered in Greater Manchester are commissioned by NHS GM; there are currently 314 providers on the 25/26 contracts list (this includes providers outside GM).
