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## PURPOSE

To receive a briefing on the new Draft Strategy for Adult Social Care in Hackney.

## OUTLINE

At our [2 March meeting](#) senior officers from ASC reported on the Council's response to the recent CQC assessment of Hackney Adult Social Care - the first council wide inspection under a new national inspection regime. The overall score achieved by the Council had been 62 and a rating of 'Requires Improvement', unluckily just 1 point below the rating needed for 'Good'. Much that was in the report however was already being acted upon.

We also discussed how the service will adapt to the new national benchmarks on adult social care and a revised National Outcomes Framework. Members asked for some work on benchmarking our statistical neighbours.

It had previously been agreed by Scrutiny Panel that performance dashboards on Adult Social Care will come to this Commission in future rather than SP.

In response to all these developments, the service will produce a new Strategy. Please find attached the following documents:
