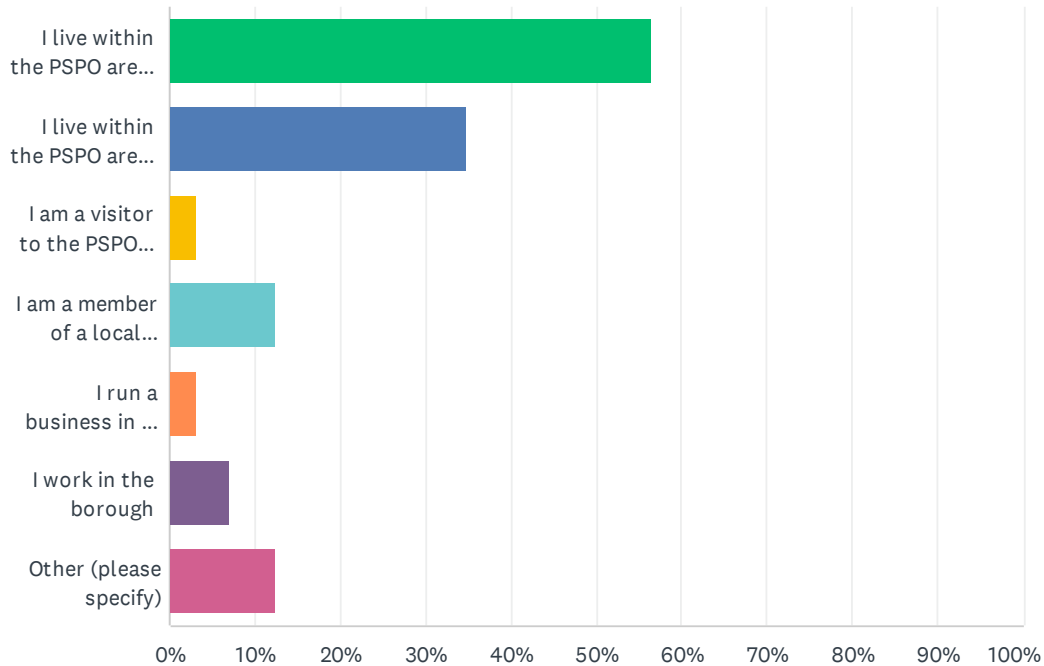


Q1 In what capacity are you responding to this consultation? Please tick all that apply

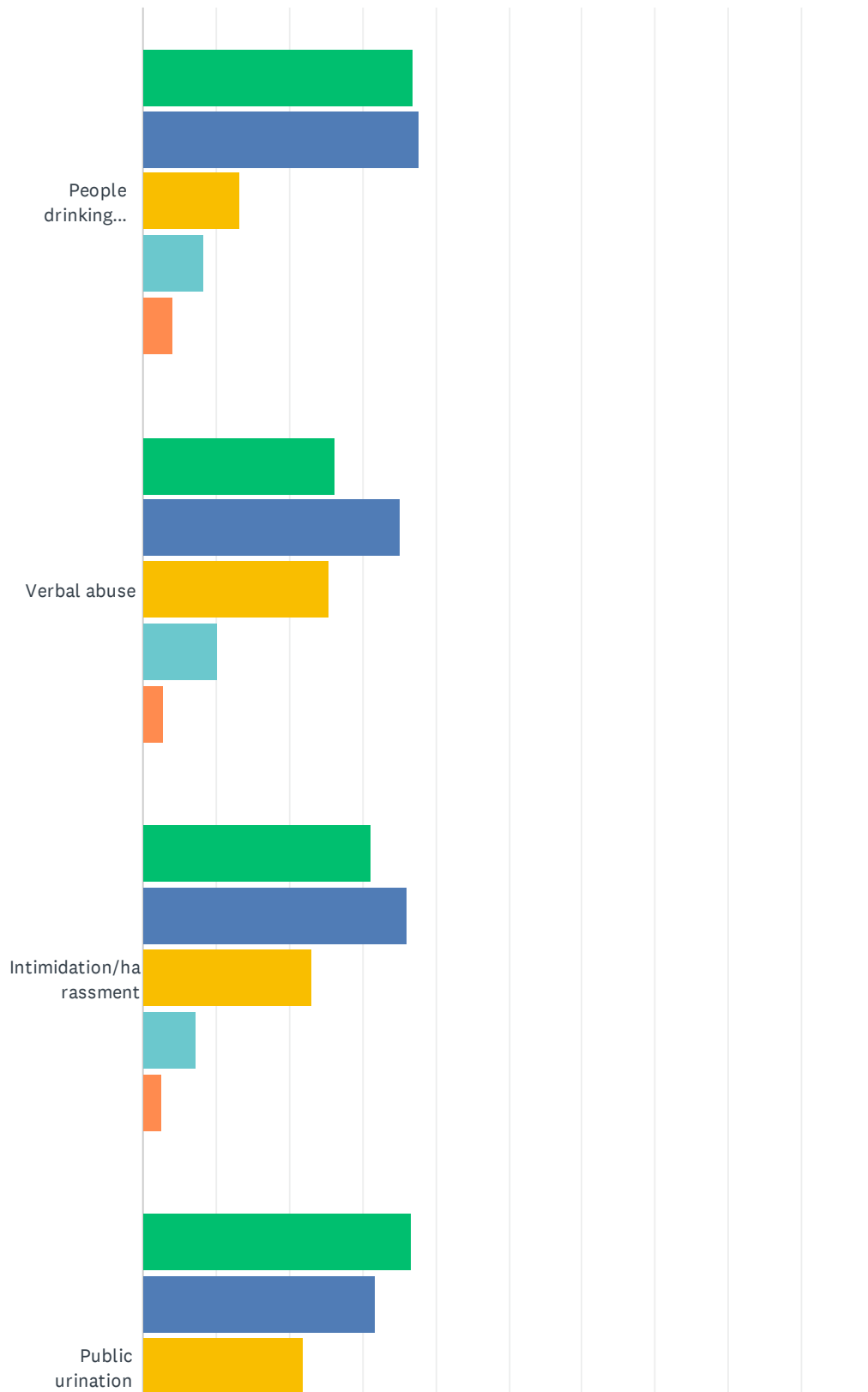

Q2 What is the postcode of your main home or business address?

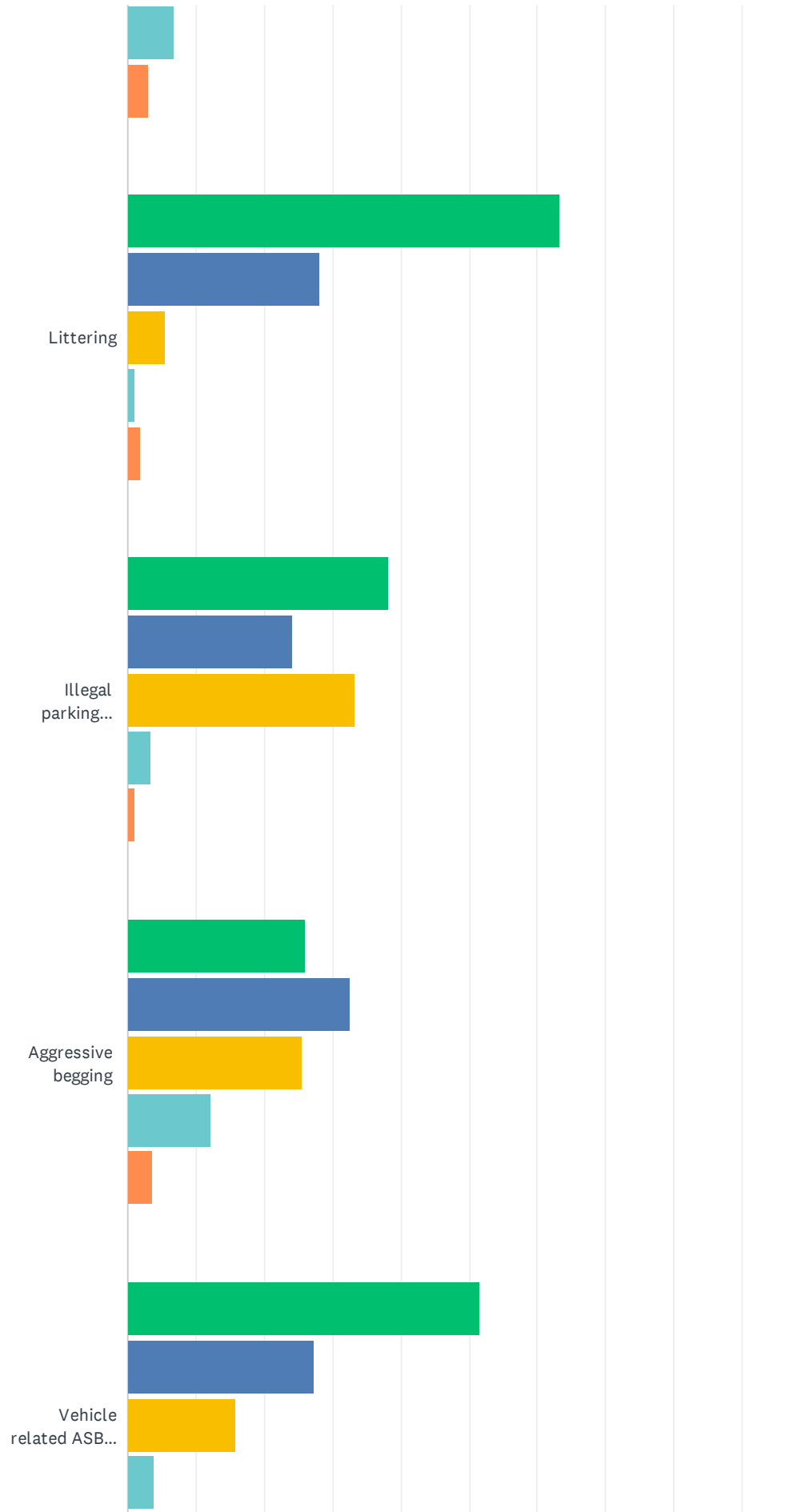

Q3 Thinking about the PSPO area, to what extent do you think that the following behaviours are a problem?

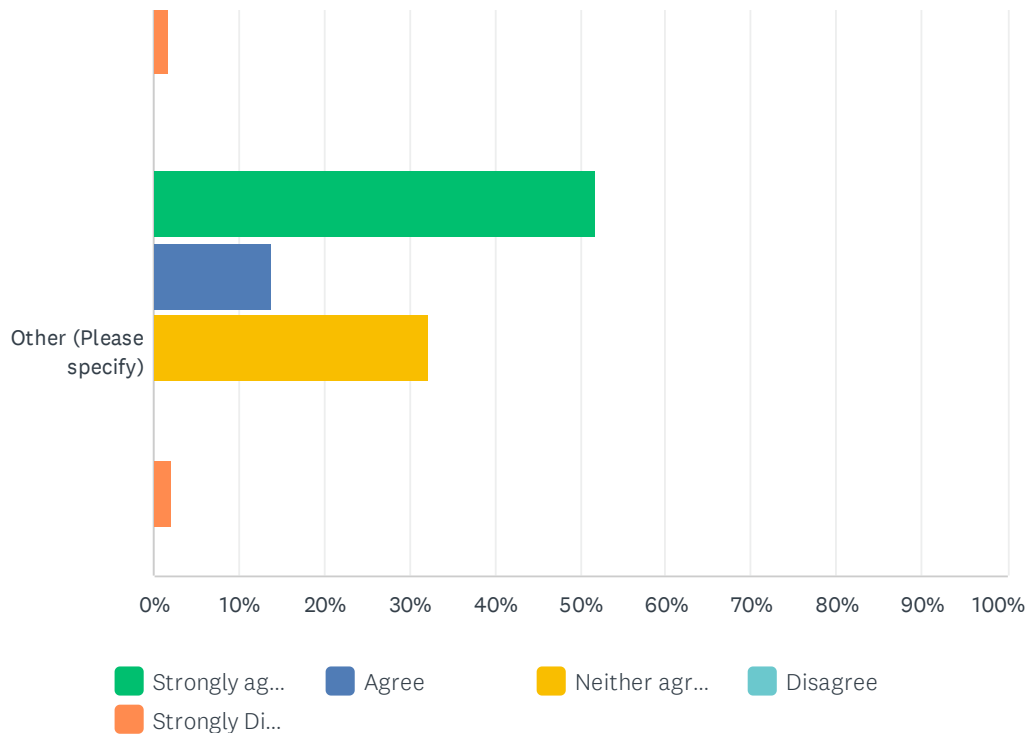

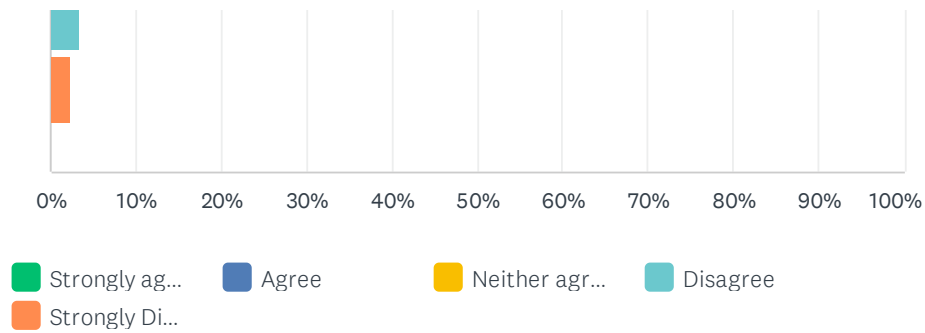

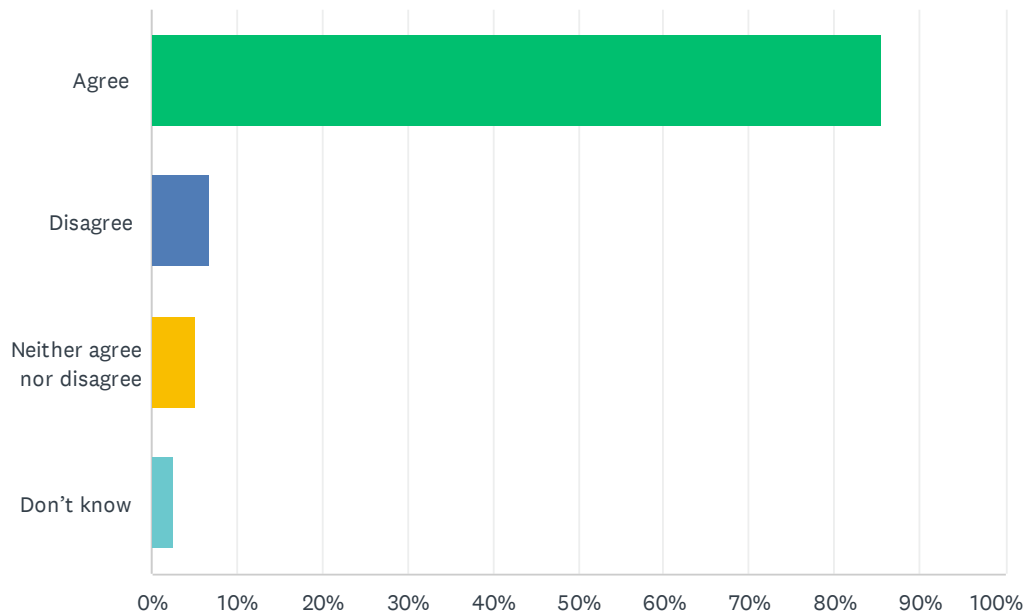

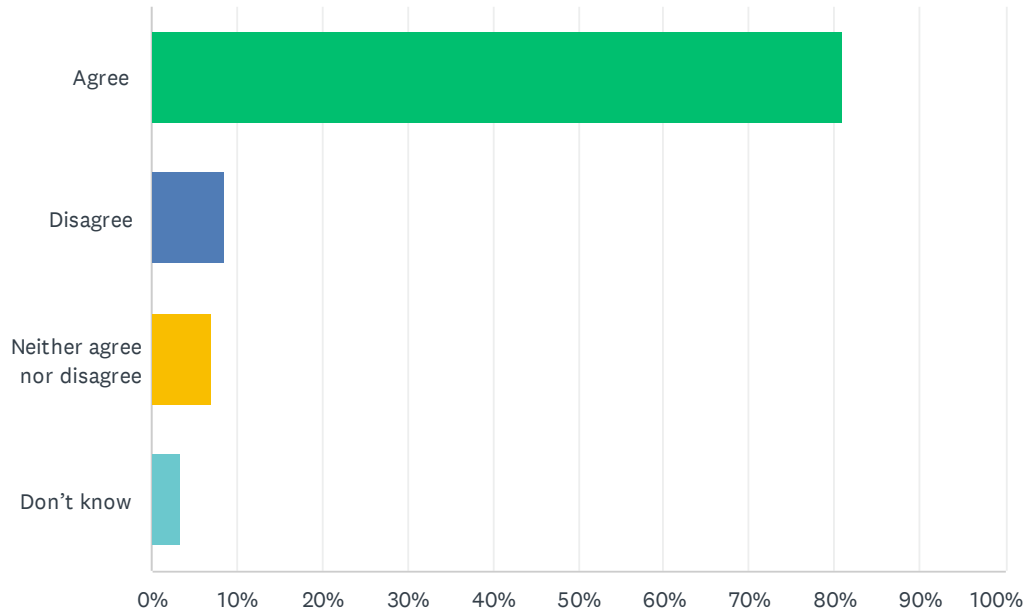

Q6 Do you agree or disagree with the proposal to extend the PSPO in the north of the Borough in the area defined on the map until October 2025?

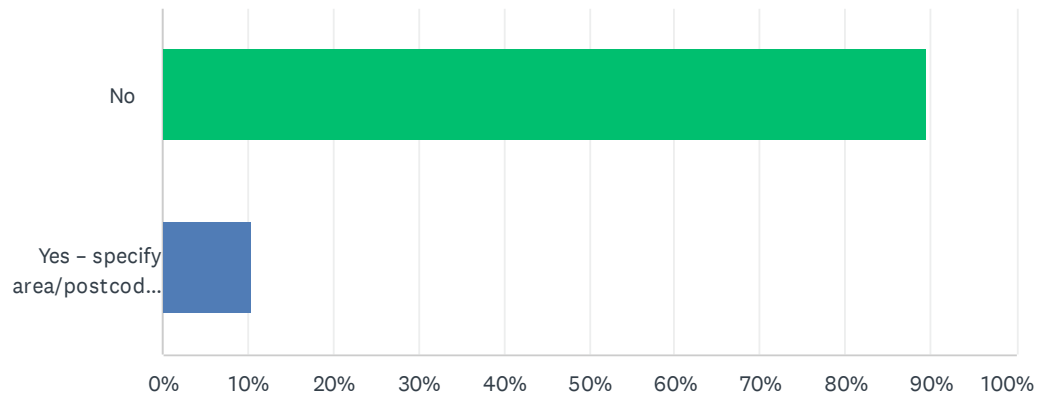

Q7 If you disagree, do you think that a PSPO should be introduced covering a smaller geographical area?

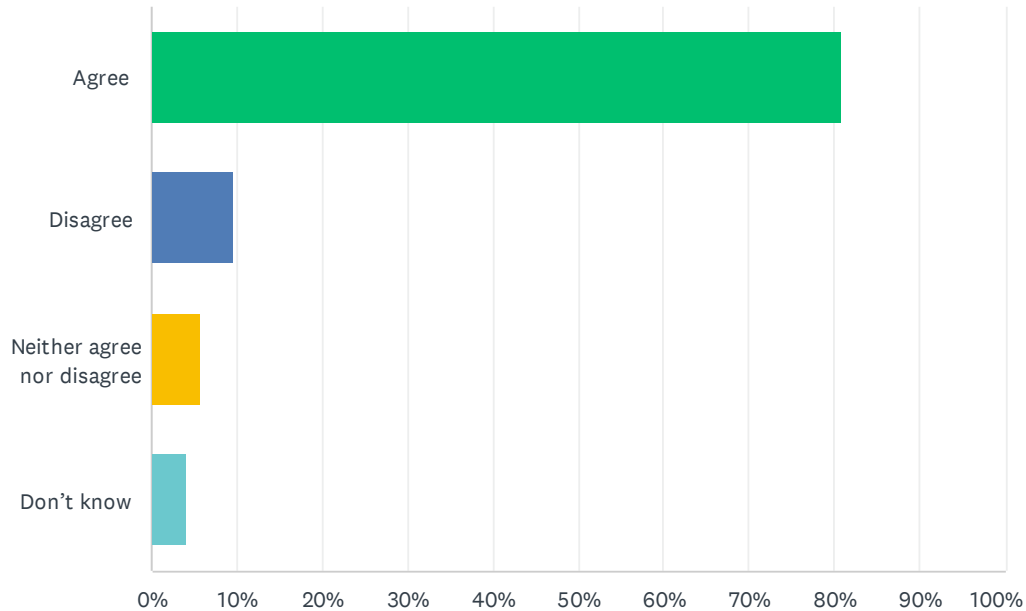

Q8 Do you agree or disagree with the proposal to extend the PSPO and to make a single borough-wide order until September 2025?

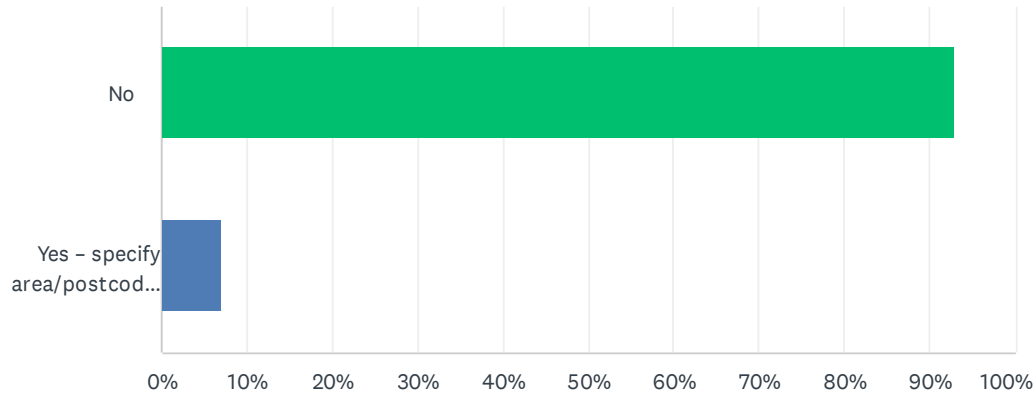

Q9 If you disagree, do you think that a PSPO should be introduced covering a smaller geographical area?

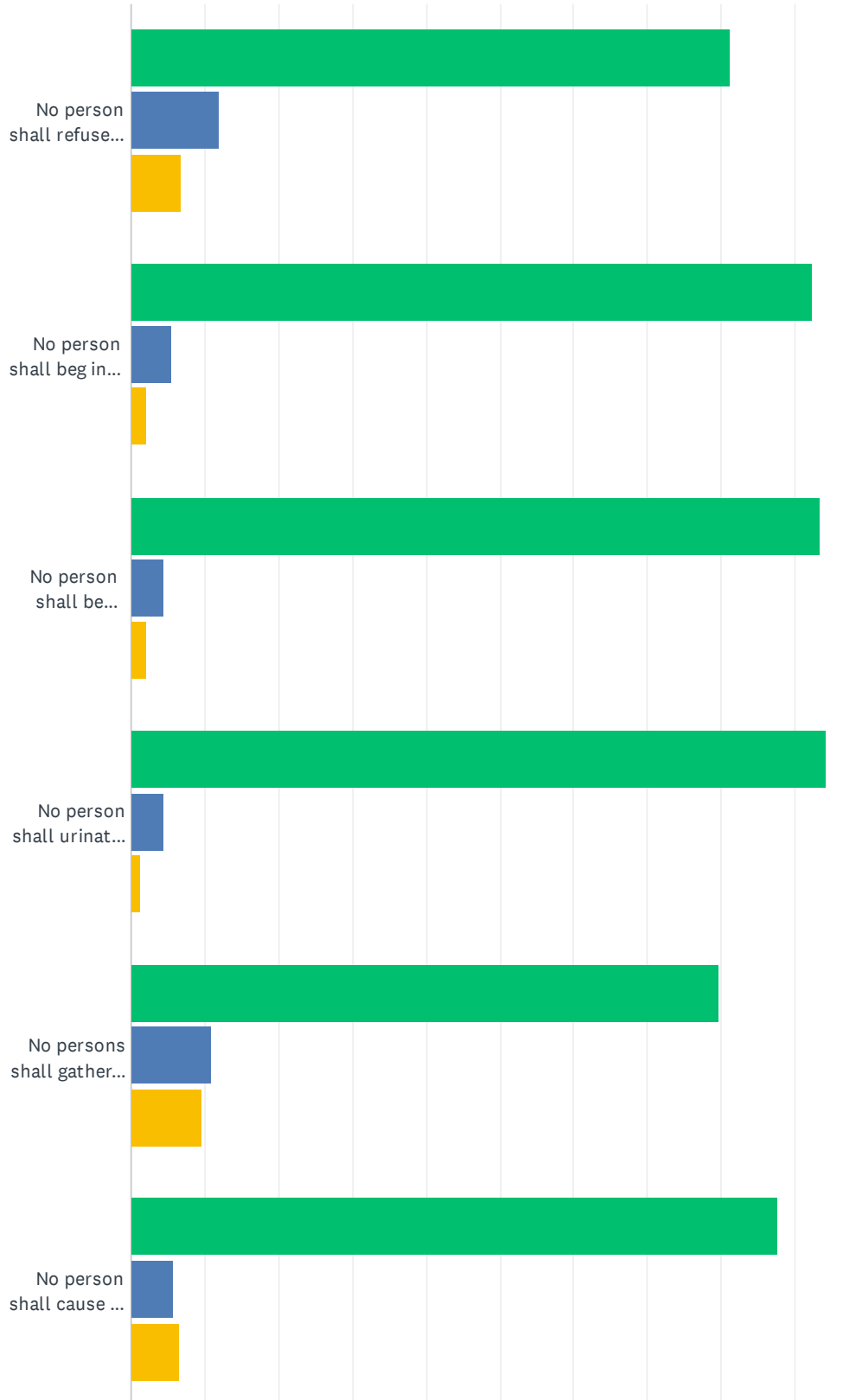

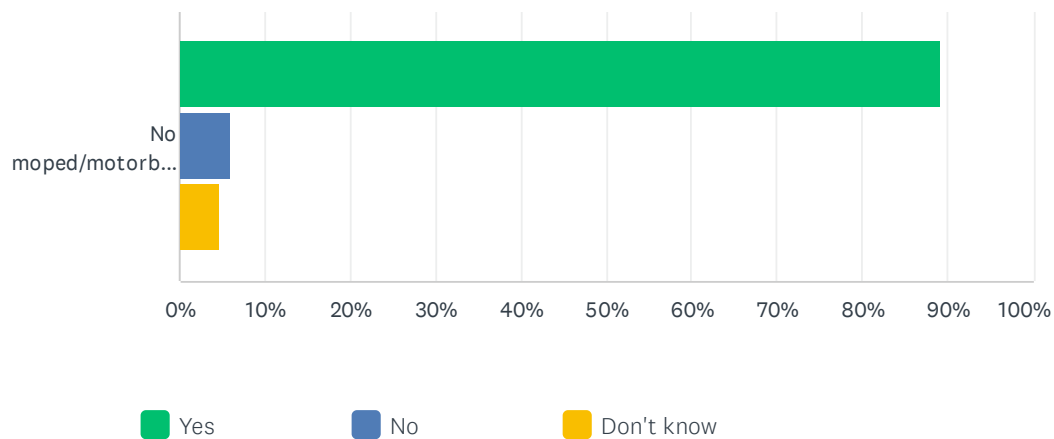
