Description of alteration and associated pattern of demand

Due to an increase in the secondary school population The London Borough of Waltham Forest is proposing to permanently expand Kelmscott School from a published admissions number (PAN) of 180 to 240. Bulge classes have been incrementally added in 2020, 2021 and 2022 to test for demand in the local area and these have been successful.

The additional places planned for September 2023 are 100% full and therefore the school is keen to make the additional intake permanent to help ensure sufficient local places are provided. This would also support one of the Local Authority's priorities – the 15 minute neighbourhood strategy (more detail on this can be found here:

This proposal has been formed in response to an increase in demand for year 7 places in the local area over the last 3 years and for September 2023 where over 85% of secondary schools were full on national offer day.
